# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## 1. AGE

The Youth Art Exhibition is artists aged 13-18 years during 2010.

## 2. SUBMISSIONS

All work is to be submitted between 3pm-6pm at the **rear** of the Darlington Hall on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November.

**Late submissions will not be accepted**

Works submitted must be accompanied by a completed **Youth Art Exhibition Form** preferably with the artist's contact details rather than their school's.

NB: work will *not* be accepted without this documentation. Forms can be downloaded from [www.darlingtonartsfestival.org.au](http://www.darlingtonartsfestival.org.au)

**Works to be hung must be fitted with a secure concealed hanging device. Three-dimensional pieces must come with adequate support to be displayed on the provided plinths.**

ONLY two works per artist may be submitted.

## 3. IDENTIFICATION

All works must be clearly and securely labelled on back/base with the **artist's** name and contact details.

## 4. SALES

**We strongly encourage the sale of submitted works.**

The prices of works should be clearly indicated on the **Youth Art Exhibition Form**.

Artists should also indicate if they are open to negotiating a price. In this situation, the prospective buyer's details will be passed on to the artist.

If work is not for sale, please indicate NFS (Not For Sale) on **Youth Art Exhibition Form**.

A commission of 10% may apply to all work priced at or above \$100.

## 5. ORIGINALITY

All works must be original and completed no more than 12 months prior to November 2010.

## 6. SELECTION

The committee will endeavour to display all works submitted. However, due to limited space, this may not always be possible and a selection process may occur.

## 7. JUDGING

The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. The judges may, at their discretion, vary the categories or decide not to make an award. The prize winners will be announced at the official opening ceremony on Friday 5 November 2010.

## 8. INSURANCE

All care will be taken and security will be provided, however no liability is accepted for any loss or damage during transit or at the Hall. Costs relating to additional insurance will be at the artist's expense.

## 9. COPYRIGHT

The Festival Committee will allow entries to be reproduced by newspaper and television for promotional purposes unless advised otherwise by the artist.

## 10. COLLECTION

Artists will be contacted by the committee if their work sells throughout the weekend. All unsold and NFS works must be collected between **5pm and 6pm, Sunday 7 November 2010**.

**Please note: all works selected for hanging must remain on show for the duration of the Exhibition.**

## 14. PAYMENT

Payment from any sale will be forwarded to the artist no later than one month after the Festival.
